

**3rd and 4th Pediatric and Wildtype GIST Clinical Conference**

**Proposed Agenda**

Leaders in the field of pediatric and wildtype GIST will attend this conference. 14 patients, who have not yet had the opportunity to attend either the 1st or the 2nd conference will also be in attendance.

On Day 1, Dr Constantine Stratakis, pediatric endocrinologist and geneticist in the National Institute of Child Health and Human Development will present the 3rd NIH Pediatric and wildtype GIST Clinical Conference Invitational Lecture. He will discuss results from our inaugural clinic assessing the importance of new genetic defects in patients with wildtype GIST. Patients will then have the opportunity to interact with physicians after the lecture.

On Day 2, 14 patients will each have a 30-minute block to discuss any questions that they may have. All of the physicians in attendance will be familiar with their medical histories, allowing us to implement such a novel format.

On Day 3, the patients will see other specialists at the NIH. The GIST physicians will discuss the sum of the information that is gathered from having accumulated 14 individual medical histories. This will a roundtable discussion that includes all of the participants listed (see Attachment D).

In prior clinic/conferences, these meetings have led to the start of innovative research hypotheses, novel imaging techniques to correlate genotype and phenotype, and the initiation of a national clinical trial. We hope that future clinics will be as productive as the inaugural clinic.
