Description: In 2007, the CNS Foundation and the UC Santa Barbara Neuroscience Research Institute will launch the *Young Neuroscientists' Workshop*. This bi-annual meeting series is intended to expose post-doctoral fellows, clinical fellows and senior graduate students to emerging thinking about childhood brain disorders, with the long-term aim of seeing more of these young investigators incorporate the study of these disorders into their career objectives.
